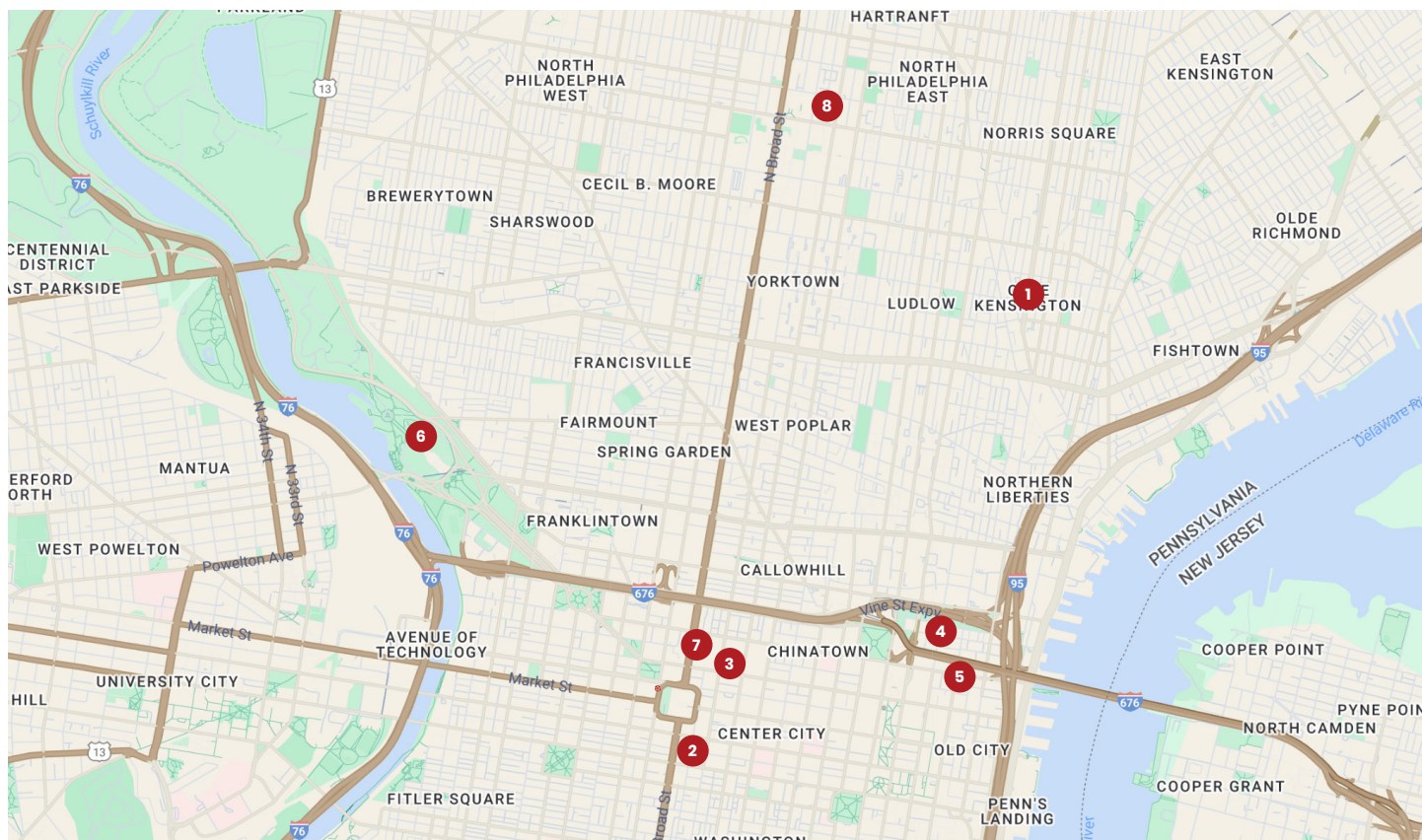


CRAFT TRAIL Philadelphia
